

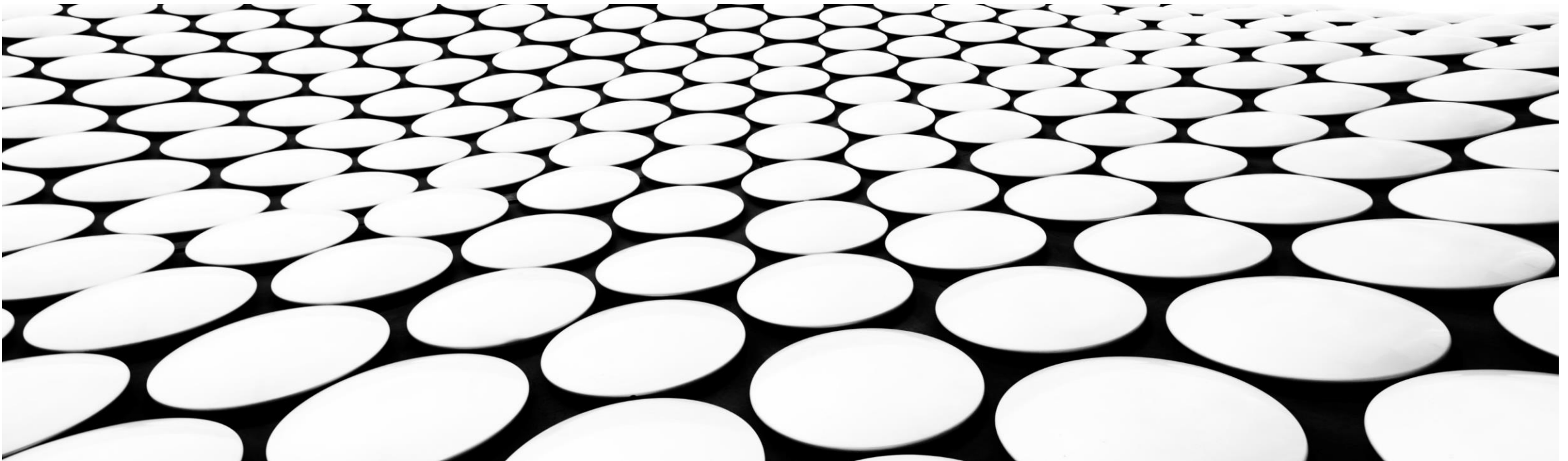

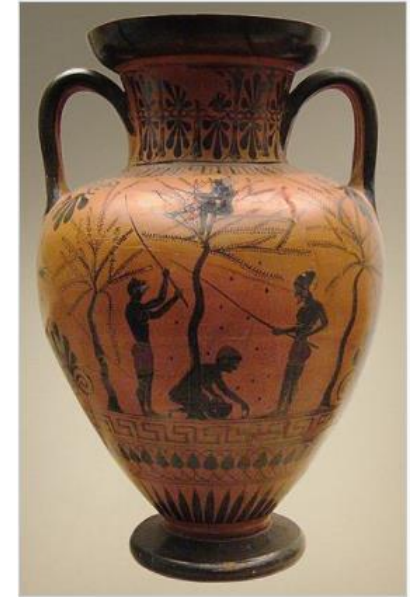

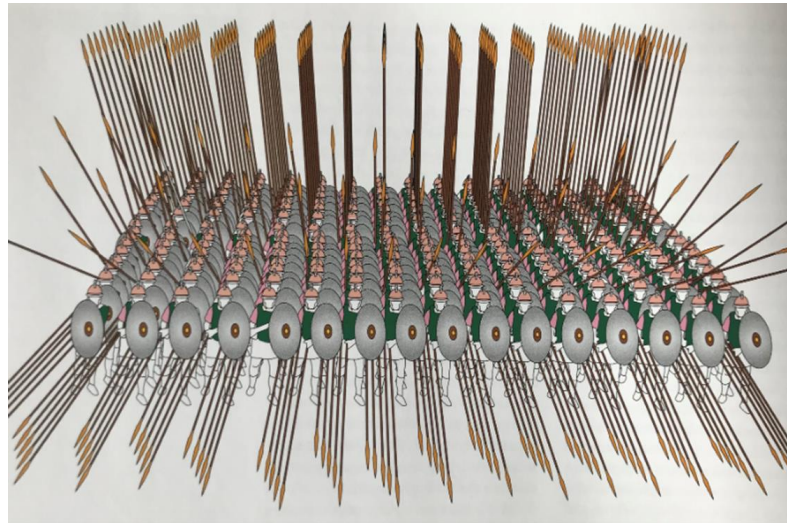

Opposing forces:

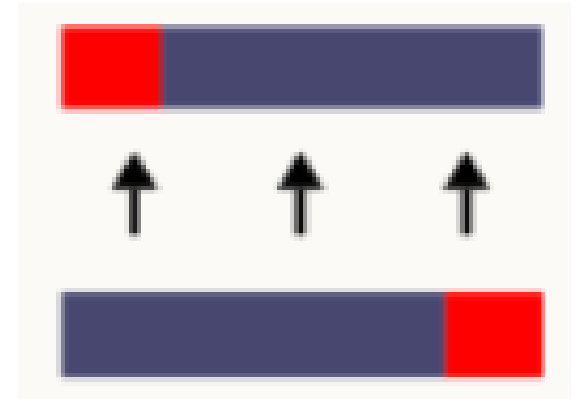
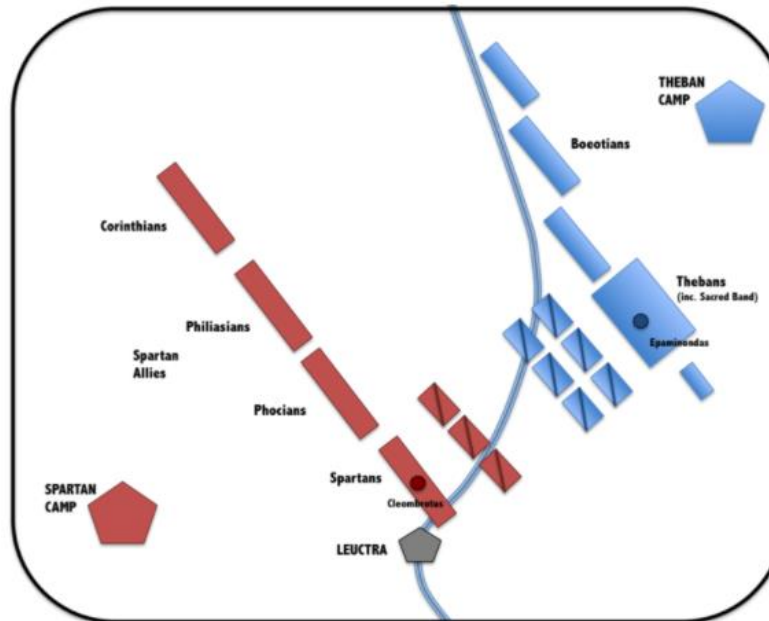
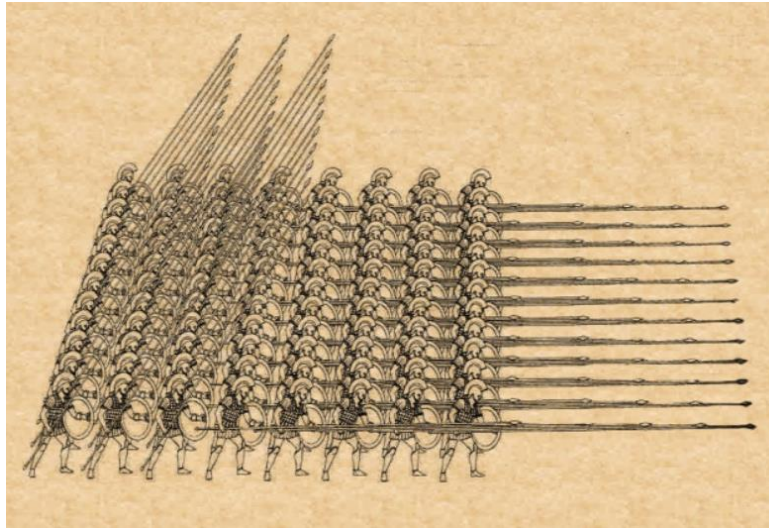
Sparta: appr. 12 000

Thebes: appr. 7–9 000

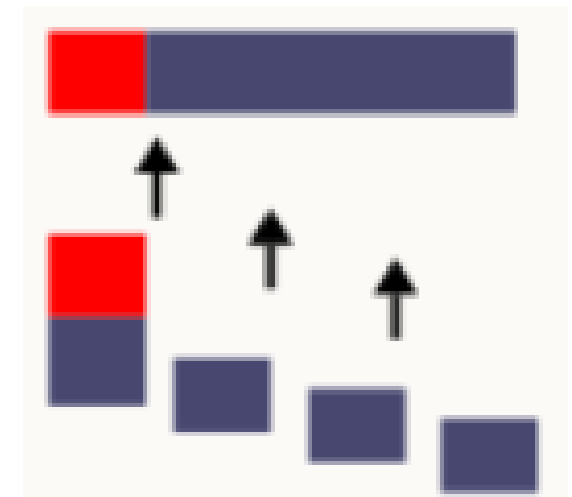
